

(1) WHAT DOES THE PUBLIC ACT OF BAPTISM SYMBOLIZE?

Romans 6:4

Acts 22:16

Galatians 3:27

It is a Biblical ordinance commemorating the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ and likewise our death and burial of self and resurrection into a new life lead by Christ (Colossians 2:12). Like Christ's public demonstration of His love for us by dying on the cross, baptism is our public commitment to to die to self and live for Him.

For believer's who been baptized in a non-biblical method, have strayed from Christ, or like the followers in Ephesus, have learned new spiritual truths rebaptism is also biblically appropriate.

(4) HOW DOES PETER DESCRIBE THE ACT OF BAPTISM?

1 Peter 3:21

The actual act of baptism will not change us but is a manifestation of the changes we are allowing Christ to do in our lives.

(5) HOW MANY TYPES OF BAPTISM DOES THE BIBLE TEACH?

Ephesians 4:5 (also see 4-6)

Just like there is only one true Lord and one true faith, there is on one Biblical method of baptism. Only full immersion in water accurately depicts what baptism symbolizes--the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ (Romans 6:4).
