Hell and the Definition of Heartless Evil? - 5

(1) IS HELL A PLACE OR AN EVENT? LET'S LOOK IN REVELATION 20-22 TO FIND OUT. WHAT MEDIUM WILL BE USED TO CLEANSE THE UNIVERSE FROM SIN, SUFFERING, AND DEATH?

Rev 20:9 (also see vs. 10, 15)

WHERE WILL THE FIRE OF HELL BURN? *Rev 20:9*

WHEN DOES IT OCCUR? *Rev 20:7 (also read 5-9)*

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF HELL-FIRE? *Rev 21:4 (also read 21:7; 22:3, 12)*

WHO AND WHAT WILL BE DESTROYED IN THE FIRE OF HELL? *Rev 20:10, 14, 15 (also read 21:8, 19, 20; 22:15; Matt 25:34-46)*

HOW LONG WILL THE FIRE OF HELL BURN? *Rev 20:9, 10 (also 22:12)*

The word translated “forever” is a relative term. For Jonah it was three days (Jonah 1:17; 2:6); for a slave, it was a lifetime (Exodus 21:6); and for the wicked, it is until they have received their just reward (Revelation 22:12).

The Bible says everlasting “punishment” not “punishing” (Matthew 25:46). The wicked are “punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord” (2 Thessalonians 1:9). The effect is eternal not the event. Their punishment is to be destroyed and everlasting separation from the Lord. Even Satan will one day receive his fair punishment and he will burn no more (Ezekiel 28:18). The fire will one day cease and we will walk on the ashes of the wicked (Malachi 4:1-3). Our God is compassionate fair and just (Psalm 87:15; 89:14) and would not in cruelty burn someone for eternity for the sins committed in a short life time on this earth. We choose either eternal life with Him or death—separation from Him the Source of life. All receive a just

reward, endless burning is not given as an option (Romans 6:22, 23).

EVERLASTING FIRE & PUNISHMENT = Mat 25:41, 46; 2 Thessalonians 1:9 = The effect of the punishment is everlasting not the event. Psalm 37:20-22, 34-38 = Wicked are cut off & destroyed. REWARD GIVEN ACCORDING TO WORKS = Matthew 16:27; Luke 12:47-47; Isaiah 3:10-11; Romans 6:23
